

Climate Change and Economic Development in Africa National Research Dissemination Workshop

The Catholic Relief Services (CRS), in collaboration with Kamuzu University of Health Sciences (KuHES), the Lilongwe University of Agriculture and Natural Resources, and the MwAPATA Institute, initiated a comprehensive study to shed light on the intricate connection between rice irrigation and malaria risk.

The three institutions later organized a dissemination workshop targeting policy makers working in malaria, public health and agriculture, to unearth policy issues in the fight against malaria and bridging the gap between agriculture and public health for the betterment of communities that grow rice.

The dissemination workshop had a panel of experts who shared their experiences based on presentations made by MwAPATA Institute, KuHES and LUANAR, respectively.
